County Swimming Championships Admission Policy

Access onto the viewing balcony at the Meridian Leisure Centre is strictly limited to the number of chairs in place. This is a stipulation of the Fire Safety certificate on the building.

This imposes a limit of 225 seated spectators at any one time. Spectators aged 5 years and under are required to be seated on an adult's knee. Spectators are **not** permitted to use their own chairs in the viewing gallery and not to place bags on seats.

There is no charge for admission to the Championship Galas so consequently parents and families of competing swimmers are kindly requested to vacate the viewing gallery between the events contested by their swimmer(s) so we can ensure that everyone gets to support their swimmer in the pool. A little co-ordination with the other members of your club will help to make this a simple and painless process.

All spectators accessing the viewing gallery will be "counted in" by the door stewards and will be "counted out" when leaving the gallery.

As stated above, access to the gallery is limited to 225 seats. Entry will be controlled by a counter at the entrance to the gallery. Please respect the role of the counter who is providing an essential role in meeting the Health & Safety requirements for the building and in place for your safety in the unlikely event of an emergency.

Competing swimmers have been provided with poolside seating and will not be allowed to use the viewing gallery between their events. Ample space exists in the Cafeteria areas for swimmers to spend time with their families between swims, should they need to.

Should we reach our capacity of 225 seated spectators the door counter will operate a one-out, one-in door policy which as stated above will be controlled by the door stewards.
