Entry Times and Seeding of Heats.

- 9. Entry times will be taken from ASA rankings or Swim Club Manager at 10pm on 1 January 2016. It is therefore important that competitors have entered (and checked) their most up to date times prior to this date. We cannot accept responsibility for times not entered / entered incorrectly on the system.
- 11. Swimmers who have previously been unable to achieve times relating to the events entered and therefore do not have entry times will have nominal times set by the head coach.
- 12. The Promoter & Championship Committee reserve the right to accept **time only** swims if space/time is available after the closing time.

Technical Rules and Competitor Sign In

- 13. All events are swum under ASA Laws and Technical Rules and swimmers will be disqualified for not complying with the relevant ASA Laws and Technical rules.
- 14. All events are Heat Declared Winners. Each event will be swum as a mixed age, based on entry time, slowest to fastest. Heats will be spearheaded.
- 15. The pool is 25 metres long and 6 lanes wide. All entry times should be converted to a 25m pool. No poolside entries will be accepted. We reserve the right to have "Over the top" starts.
- 16. The Championship Committee reserves the right to amalgamate events and/or refuse entry to the championships without discussion. Anything not covered by these rules is at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

Spectators
